The RKS has taken up many activities for the welfare of the patients, the patients' family members who come to the hospital and for the staff of the health institution itself.

Success stories of RKS:

Rogi Kalyan Samiti -under Rongjeng CHC.

The Hospital Management Society/ Rogi Kalyan Samiti under Rongjeng CHC was constituted on 02nd/February/2007. The Society comprises of Chairperson, Co-chairperson, Member Secretary and other executive members. Other members are also represented from other line departments such as Community and Rural Development(C&RD), ICDS, local NGOs, Church leaders and Public representatives. The RKS aims to upgrade and modernize health services, to supervise the proper implementation of National Health Programmes, to organize outreach services and health camps to all the rural areas.

The Rongjeng CHC building remained unpainted for many years due to financial problems. But, with the financial assistance received from the NRHM through the funds for the year 2010-2011 the RKS has decided to go ahead with the painting of the building. The complete work on the CHC building was estimated at the cost of Rs.85, 000/- (Eighty five thousand only) and the work has been completed within one month. The present Rongjeng CHC building not only looks beautiful with bright colors but it has also become more hygienic and habitable for the sick and the other people who comes to avail the different services at the CHC.



Frequent power failure in the area has greatly hampered the smooth and timely health delivery system of the health institution. In order to avoid unnecessary inconvenience and for prompt and timely delivery of services (emergencies, lab reports, etc) the RKS under Rongjeng CHC have also unanimously decided to purchase a Generator which cost Rs.53000/- (Fifty-three thousand only) . The purchase made on generator had greatly help out to substitute the frequent power failure in times of emergency like delivery cases and many other urgent office works.



Rongjeng CHC also faces great problems of space due to small hospital area and therefore its always a problems in wastes disposal be it solid or liquid wastes, which results in practice of unhygienic waste disposal systems that are harmful to the patients and to the natural surroundings. Therefore in order to stop this, the RKS decided to construct a septic tank for disposing of waste material and incinerator for the burning of non-degradable substances. The total costs for the construction is Rs.50,000/- (Fifty thousand only).
